

PLANNING AND LAND USE

- At the September 2007 Forum meeting, members were provided with information on the methodology being used by Planning SA to engage Local Government and other local stakeholders in the process of establishing Regional Land Use Frameworks to review and revise the Regional Planning Strategy. This paper provides an update in relation to the current Regional Land Use Framework Projects.
- The Mayors of the City Council of Mt Gambier and the District Council of Grant have met with the Minister for Urban Development and Planning and advised him that the Draft Greater Mt Gambier Master Plan has been endorsed by both Councils.
- As a consequence the Draft Greater Mt Gambier Master Plan was advertised and placed on public consultation until 7 December 2007 as a prelude to consideration of feedback and ultimately incorporation into the Regional volume of the Planning Strategy.
- The Mayors of the City of Victor Harbor and the District Council of Alexandrina have met with the Minister for Urban Development and Planning and advised him that the Draft South Coast Master Plan has been endorsed by both Councils.
- As a consequence the Draft South Coast Master Plan was advertised and placed on public consultation until 14 December as a prelude to consideration of feedback and ultimately its incorporation into the Outer Metropolitan Adelaide Region volume of the Planning Strategy.
- The Draft Far North Regional Land Use Framework and Mid North Regional Land Use Framework have both been distributed to Local Government, Government agencies and key stakeholders for comment.
- The first workshop to develop the Murray and Mallee Regional Land Use Framework was held at Karoonda on 31 October.
- Cabinet recently endorsed the Yorke Peninsula Regional Land Use Framework. Following its gazettal it will become the first Land Use Framework to be incorporated into the Regional volume of the Planning Strategy.
